NATIONAL COCONUT FARMERS REGISTRY SYSTEM (NCFRS)

About the Survey:

- General Appropriations Act of 2012 mandates the registration of all beneficiaries of the different programs and projects of the government
- The National Coconut Farmers Registry System (NCFRS) serves as a tool to ensure effective and efficient planning, delivery and monitoring of development programs and projects and proper allocation and prioritization of scarce government resources
- The NCFRS is done through a national survey and complete enumeration or listing of landowners, tenants, leaseholders, and farm workers
- It is undertaken using NCFRS Registry Form which have been developed, pre-tested and implemented by PCA
- This is also in pursuit of our mandate to complete the survey of the coconut farmers and farm workers in view of the immediate passing of the Coco Levy Trust Fund Bill

Objectives:

- To continue with the registration of all the coconut farmers and farm workers using the prescribed PCA survey questionnaires
- To generate a complete and accurate coconut farmers and farm workers' registry
- To establish and maintain a databank that will serve as a repository of essential information on coconut farmers and farm workers in the country.
